Purpose

The <u>Community Partnership Panel</u> is hosted by Freeport-McMoRan to keep the community informed about operational activities and to foster open and ongoing dialogue to develop thoughtful solutions to address community issues.

Safety Share

The safety and health of all Freeport-McMoRan employees, along with our commitment to the environment, are of the highest priority. Our objective is zero workplace injuries and occupational illness.

Currently COVID-19 restrictions remain in place at our operations, such as social distancing, required mask use and temperature checks. Chino and Tyrone will be holding COVID-19 vaccination clinics for employees on site June 9 and 23.

Chino Operations continues to operate under current mine plan at a reduced capacity compared to 2020.

- Chino is on target with its forecast headcount of more than 600 employees and approximately 50 contractors with no anticipation at this point in time of increasing headcount.
- Chino has initiated a Freeport Edge Influencer Team to help achieve the goal of redefining the future and developing a culture of which all employees can be proud. The influencer team consists of individuals selected by their peers as being trustworthy leaders.

Tyrone Operations continues to have a strong safety record, achieving 473 days and counting without a reportable incident.

- Tyrone is currently piloting two programs. The first, titled Leadership Edge, is centered around supervisor development. The second is a pilot wellness program which takes a holistic approach to the health and well-being of all employees.
- Tyrone continues to pursue permits related to the Emma and Little Rock pit.
- The Emma project will be a 3-5 year duration and encompasses approximately 130 acres. Tyrone continues to engage directly with neighbors related to this project and presented to the Board of County Commissioners on June 8.
- Little Rock has been operating since 2010 and includes a modest expansion that adds nine months to Tyrone's mine life. A public hearing for this project was held on June 3 and public comments were accepted by MMD until June 17.
