Tailings Management Update

- Polymer-based dust suppressant testing
- Approved for use on 90% of dam surface
- Another test will be completed this year with the intent of gaining 100% use approval from engineer of record
- Record rainfall in July
- Dust suppressant held up satisfactorily, however in some areas was washed away. Brought in additional resources to re-establish damaged crust areas.

Activities / Ongoing Work

- Pipe lift road construction complete. Currently lifting pipe from old road to the new road. Still on track to fully complete by end 2021.

Stormwater Management

Surface Water Quality is regulated under the Clean Water Act with the purpose of restoring and maintaining the chemical, physical and biological integrity of the Nation's waters ("Waters of the United States"):

- Per Arizona law, our stormwater is managed by a multi-sector general permit
- This was adapted specifically to mining in 2010
- Sierrita is permitted to discharge stormwater from areas on our property that meet this standard
