- Routine erosion repair at the mine will occur in September and October
- General office roof replacement will take place in October and November

- Water treatment plant maintenance/improvements
  - Replaced pumps and conducted other minor maintenance activities
- Water distribution system operations
- Power distribution system resilience/maintenance
  - Will continue to work with Pima County and APS to reduce number and frequency of power outages
  - Transformer projects with Pima County have been completed

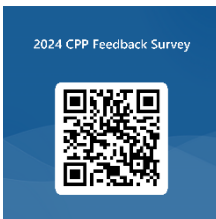
