### Ajo Operations Update

- 44kV substation construction activities tentatively planned to commence in October 2020
- The 29th new plant species was discovered in Papua, Indonesia
  - An employee of Freeport-McMoRan since 1997, decades-long contribution to biological and ecological research led to the naming of two plant species after him
    - Diplycosia puradyatmikai officially designated in June 2020
    - Papuacalia titoi officially designated in 2000
- Ajo operations has a pollinator garden located in front of the administration building. We look forward to partnering with the community in the future to plant more pollinator gardens.

### Ajo Improvement Company Update

- Bryan Rodriguez has accepted an engineering position in the corporate office.
- Second electrician position currently open
- Gila Bend to Ajo 230 kV Line CEC time extension
  - Notice does not indicate new activity around a mine restart
  - Extension of an existing permit to keep opportunity for critical infrastructure
  - Draft Recommended Order and Opinion – meeting scheduled for 10 a.m., September 22, 2020
