 - 9 inches of rain resulted in a slope failure and a stuck shovel
 - The third quarter average from 2010 to 2018 exceeded performance by 4%
- Key milestones:
 - State land purchase completed
 - Completed land exchange agreement with local ranchers
 - First concentrate processsed through the new cleaner plant
