### Purpose

The [Community Partnership Panel](#) is hosted by Freeport-McMoRan to keep the community informed about operational activities and to foster open and ongoing dialogue to develop thoughtful solutions to address community issues.

### Safety Share

The safety and health of all Freeport-McMoRan employees, along with our commitment to the environment, are of the highest priority. Our objective is zero workplace injuries and occupational illness.

Spectrum Health held COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Bagdad on February 24 and 25 (and March 24/25 for follow-up vaccinations). These clinics were open to:

- All Freeport-McMoRan employees – essential workers
- Bagdad residents within phases 1a and 1b of the Yavapai County schedule

The Copper Mark was awarded to Cerro Verde in Peru, El Abra in Chile, Atlantic Copper (first in their respective countries) and Miami and the El Paso refinery. Other U.S. sites are scheduled to be assessed in 2021.

### State land purchase update

The purchase of approximately 17,000 acres of Arizona State Trust Land was completed in early 2020. The primary purpose of purchasing this land is to provide additional storage of tailings material when the current Bagdad operations tailings facility reaches the current permitted elevation.

### Sycamore tailings storage facility permitting and support

A completed jurisdictional waters analysis of the area was submitted to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in February 2021. Data recovery work on identified cultural sites is anticipated in the second quarter of 2021. This will include surface mapping and logging of artifacts and some select excavations.

In response to the increase in COVID-19 cases, Freeport-McMoRan donated more than 13,100 KN95 masks to healthcare facilities and schools in our operating communities.
