Local Updates

- SULFATE MITIGATION
 - Long-term groundwater monitoring, an option selected by ADEQ, is continuing.
 - A presentation was given to the Panel which provided a detailed update on this work.

COPPER QUEEN BRANCH

- Reclamation work along Whelan Avenue in Bakerville has been completed.
- Removal of a 10" HDPE pipe and placement of a soil cap along the railroad grade in Bakerville has been completed.
- CQB submitted an Aquifer Protection Permit application to ADEQ at the end of December last year. The application is in the review stage.
- Sometime this year we are planning to remove the concentrate thickeners, the large round structures across the entrance to Lowell.

RECLAMATION

- Reclamation of the South Bisbee Stockpile is scheduled to begin in 3rd Qtr. 2018.
- Interstate Mining Compact Commission's (IMCC) 2018 National Reclamation Award for voluntary reclamation of CTSA received.
