Tailings Management Update:

Berm push on South Dam will start in December / January and will be ongoing for 4-5 months

- Continued success in dust emissions management
 - Trial with polymer suppressant ongoing
 - Daily satellite images helps direct efforts
- Erosion repairs ongoing from monsoon season

Sierrita's Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) was recently renewed and combined with the Twin Buttes APP

- This will simplify reporting and reduce redundancies
- Sierrita's Title V Air Permit is also due for renewal and is expected to enter its public comment period before the end of 2022
