Current employment at Morenci Operations is approximately 3,500. Safford Operations currently has 930 employees. And, the CASC has 215 employees.

Since 2007, Freeport-McMoRan has been hiring college interns, giving them the opportunity to work on professional projects and gain relevant hands-on experience. Morenci Operations will hire 50 interns for the 2018 summer. These interns will be working on a variety of projects.

An overview of the Greviance Management System was provided by the corporate sustainable development team.
