

In August 2024, as part of a larger community resilience effort called Community Heart & Soul, Henderson operations along with the Kremmling Chamber Commerce. ### AN IMPACT PROGRESS REPORT: CLEAR CREEK EARLY LEARNING CENTER



2018 funding from Freeport-McMoRan for an Early Childhood Needs Assessment has led to a Clear Creek feasibility study for the development of a new early learning center, and plans to move forward with the project. In 2022, additional Freeport funding supported the creation of a business model for the center. Preparing for construction, The Clear Creek Learning Center, Mountain Trails, located in Idaho Springs, will bring up to 69 additional early learning seats in five classrooms to Clear Creek County's I-70 corridor. These seats are for students aged 16-weeks through school age and will allow families to increase their workforce participation and improve their students' kindergarten readiness. The Center will offer sliding-scale tuition, provide employees a living wage with full benefits, and be open five days per week with extended before and after school care.
