Miami operations employee volunteers hosted a booth titled "Pollinators and You" at the Gila County STEM Festival in April 2024. Volunteers promoted Miami's pollinator garden, which is open to the public, and taught over **250 booth visitors** about Freeport-McMoRan's pollinator conservation and Corporate Lands for Learning initiatives, the vital role pollinators have in plant production and food supply, as well as pollinator friendly practices—providing food, water and rest spots in your own yard. Visitors were given pollinator-friendly plant kits. Miami operations provides \$10,000 annually to the Southern Gila County Education Services Agency (aka Gila County School Superintendents Office) for this and other signature STEM events and has brought pollinator education to STEMFest since its inception more than a decade ago.

AN IMPACT PROGRESS REPORT: GILA COMMUNITY COLLEGE



Freeport-McMoRan has been a longtime supporter of workforce development programs at Gila Community College. In 2022, Freeport provided two professional instructors to teach classes for college and high school students, which led to a \$150K matching **grant** to upgrade College's Regional Training Center's (RTC) welding and HVAC programs. In 2023, Freeport provided \$35K for three manikins for the Gila Pueblo Campus nursing program. The use of manikins provides students with realworld scenarios to increase critical thinking during clinical rotations.

Freeport's most recent support has been four part-time Electrical and Instrumentation instructors to teach a program for the Cobre Valley Institute of Technology Career and Technical Education District. Using the College's RTC, which is leased from Freeport at no cost, 18 high school students are engaged in instruction in a high-wage, high-demand, training program. These students will be eligible for summer internship programs and entry-level positions with Freeport.
