Safety and Operations Update

- Safety: Total Recordable Incident Rate YTD = 1 (2020 Target = 2.33)
- In response to COVID-19, Miami implemented protocols for employees and visitors
- Miami smelter to operate at full capacity during 2020 and beyond with ongoing technical improvements and preparation for a major maintenance turnaround in 2021

Environmental Update

A visible emission at the acid plant was observed on January 16, 2020. Corrosion at the top of the process gas inlet nozzle caused a small hole. Miami operations promptly reported event to ADEQ and initiated corrective actions. Repairs and integrity testing of acid plant equipment has been completed. This emission event resulted in a NOV which was closed by ADEQ on February 26, 2020.

Community Development Update

Our Commitment to Social Investing

In response to COVID-19, medical and non-medical supplies were procured and donated to healthcare facilities and first responders in our communities.

A total of approximately 4,700 items were donated to hospitals and clinics across North America. At Miami operations, Freeport-McMoRan donated surgical masks and Tyvek suits to Cobre Valley

Freeport-McMoRan convened chamber of commerce and economic development directors from our operating communities to discuss COVID-19 rural community response strategies, lessons learned and resources.

A coordination call was held with United Way CEOs in our operating communities to discuss COVID- 19 response strategies and to offer an opportunity to learn and apply successful response strategies in other communities.

- Miami Unified School District – distance learning computers and Wi-Fi
- Nalwoodi Denzhone – garden and market stand for San Carlos Apache Tribe
- Cobre Valley Youth Club – childcare for essential workers
- Gila Community Food Bank – increased food supply to meet demand
