Tyrone Operations Update

- Successfully achieved 2019 mine plan
- Vision 20/20 celebration event will commemorate successfully mining until the year 2020, a target achieved by diligent work across the organization.
- Rebuilding the 24 shovel represents an investment in Tyrone's future
- Evaluating options for construction of a new pit on existing mine property, south of operations.
 - Project in early phases
 - Exploratory drilling scheduled to take place in 2020

Chino Operations Update

- 2020 Objectives generate highest value, have our best day every day, transform Chino to a 3rd quartile producer, build the capabilities of our people and leaders.
- Cobre Haul Road Bridge community questions received regarding structural integrity/stability. Construction joints that are part of the original build design of the bridge wall have been mistaken by some as cracks or settling. The bridge meets engineering design specs and is approved by the Department of Transportation.
- Using advanced analytics to recommend setpoints that increase copper production in real-time.
- New tailings impoundment is essential for continued operations.

 - Community meetings with neighbors, CPP and other stakeholders will be scheduled in coming months to provide more details
