Freeport partnered with Eastern Arizona College for the successful launch of its new Diesel Technology Program. The College launched two cohorts for the program - one for their General Population students and one for dual-enrollment high school students. Both cohorts were at capacity, with 15 students each, ahead of the August program start date. The Safford and Morenci mine sites further supported the effort with a combined total grant of \$100,000 to help the College acquire additional resources needed to start the program.

"With the funding from Freeport three years ago, we have been able to expand the program and will have 22 teams, across those years, formed by the end of this year. We have been able to register for a second competition for the second semester called Lunar Legacy that focuses on space science and has an event in May at NAU...We started with one robotics team each year for each semester and now we have four teams for first semester and five teams for second semester. Because of this growth, Thatcher Middle School now hosts a regional qualifier for the First Lego League season for teams to participate and lessen travelling costs for teams."
